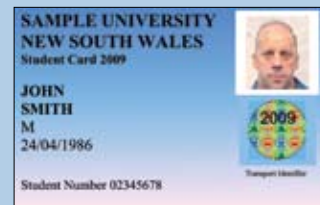

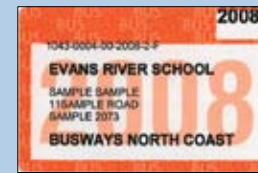
Child fare applies to children aged between 4 and 15 (inclusive). A Proof of Age Card can be used to confirm the date a young person turns 16.

- Cards must show an expiry date, but periods of validity differ for:
 - Students: short/single semester or full year cards
 - Jobseeker: 3 month limit
 - Apprentices & Trainees: life of Card of up to 3 years

- All forms of Student Cards must show a RailCorp concession sticker or printed symbol to be valid.
 - Some student identification Cards issued by tertiary organisations are for up to 5 years, with a printed RailCorp concession symbol for the first year. This type of Card must have a RailCorp sticker in subsequent years.

- An assistant animal which is:
 - A Guide Dog
 - A Hearing Dog accredited by Lions Australia Hearings Dogs
 - Covered by a RailCorp issued Assistance Animal Permit
